**Instructions: Explanation/clarification of responsibilities on Rubric**

1. **The power point presentation needs to be creative and MUST include the book title and author presented on the front page**
  
2. **Novels: Requirements**
  - a. Novels can be from any genre
  - b. Novels must be at least 200 pages
  - c. Novels must be grade level equivalent
  - d. Novels must be something you haven't read before
  - e. Must complete a reader response journal
  - f.

**A. Power Point Presentation must include:**

  - a. **Setting:** Picture/Representation: At least two or three major settings within the novel
  - b. **Characters:** Pictures/Symbols: Must have visuals for the characters within the novel. All the main characters: Protagonist/Antagonist:
  - c. **Major events-** Ex. Complications or conflict that advance the story towards its climax: Pictures/Symbols
  - d. **Climax-** that peak moment, scenario that resolves the conflicts presented: Pictures/Symbols
  - e. **Tone/Mood/Attitude:** Pictures/Symbols that represent the overall idea
  - f. **Moral or Theme-** Pictures/Symbols
  
3. **Oral Presentation:**
  - a. **Voice/Posture/Eye Contact:** Please make sure to speak clearly, stand-up straight while facing the class, and make consistent eye contact with your audience.
  - b. **Enthusiasm:** Please express an enthusiastic nature towards the exercise and novel you have read.
  - c. **Content/clarity/organization:** Please make sure that you practice your presentation before hand. Make sure that you have a chronology of events, and that the students will be able to follow your presentation. Also, you may use note cards to help you, but please do not read directly from them or your power point presentation.
  
4. **Reading Response Journals:**
  - a. Reading Response Journals will be turned in at the end of your presentation. Please have name on journal.
